# SCHOOL PROCEDURES



One of our primary concerns is the safety of our students and staff. We have procedures we want to make you aware of that help our school run smoothly. Please retain this first newsletter with important information for yearly procedures.

#### Safe Arrival

Please report an absence for your student in advance, up to the start of the school day on the date of your child's absence by:

- Toll-Free Number -Parents/guardians can call 1-833-582-6940 to report future absences using an automated system.
- 2. PowerSchool Parent/Student Portal Parents/guardians can log in to https://sishrsb.ednet.ns.ca/public/ to access the SchoolMessenger website to report future absences.
- 3. SchoolMessenger App -Parents/guardians can download the SchoolMessenger app for Android and iOS devices and will sign up using their PowerSchool username (full email).

All three methods are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Up to five consecutive absences can be recorded at once. Please visit hrce.ca/SafeArrival for more information.

Please ensure we have a valid working phone number, and we can contact you

Supervision starts 8:05 do not arrive before

Please ensure your child arrives on time to limit disruptions to important routines

Parents must call/email to make an appointment with the principal, vice principal or teachers to ensure availability

Visitors must sign in at the office, wear a visitor badge and state a reason for each visit

Teachers will generally respond to email within 2 business days

We are a scent and nut aware school

No pets! For your safety, student safety and pet safety (Service Dogs permitted)

No smoking or vaping on school property

**Proper forms are required for the administration of** <u>any</u> medications. No medications will be administered to students by school staff during school hours unless it is necessary and prescribed by a health care professional. This includes any over the counter medications.

Please ensure we have current custody or court documents if applicable

Talk to your child about crosswalk safety

All students will ride their assigned bus/buses only

Children are not permitted to open outside doors or answer the doorbell

Hold Secure Practice, Lockdown Practice and Fire Drills We will practice these security measures throughout the year to develop an awareness and expectations for safety.

No Driving/Parking on School Property There is absolutely no driving/parking on school property for unauthorized vehicles without prior arrangements during the school day. Please drive slow and watch for crosswalks. When buses arrive, do not drive, or walk around them. This protects all of us and especially our students.

### **Bus Information**



All bus students must have their name on the bus manifest and ride <u>only</u> their assigned bus. Please log into <u>Bus Planner</u> to access your child's account and view your child's bussing information. You will need your child's provincial student number (300 number found at the top of the report card or on the Power School parent portal.)

Please inform your child's teacher and ensure that you both know the correct afternoon bus number and driver name before the first day of school. Thank you for your cooperation as we work together on safe bussing.
